Bring business before assembly (main move)	I move to...	You can not interrupt a discussion. Your name has to be on the board. Once you have raised your hand and the President has acknowledged you, you may have the floor.	Yes.	Yes. This move is almost always followed by discussion.	Yes.	Majority rule. (Quorum)
Limit or extend discussion	I move to limit/extend discussion to...	You can not interrupt a speaker; your name must be on the board.	Yes.	No.	Yes.	2/3.
Request Information	Point of Information	You can interrupt an ongoing discussion. You need not be recognized by the President. You are free to call out your question anytime from your seat.	No.	No.	No.	None.
Rise to a question of Privilege (e.g. To have yourself or someone else excused from the room)	Point of Privilege	You can interrupt in the middle of discussion; you do not have to have your name on the board. However your question of privilege must be acknowledged by the President.	No.	No.	No.	None.

Lay aside temporarily	I move to table...	Your name has to be on the board, you can not interrupt a speaker who already has the floor.	Yes.	No.	No.	Seconded Only.
Postpone the move to a different art of the day's agenda	I move to postpone the move to...	Your name has to be on the board, you can not interrupt a speaker who already has the floor.	Yes.	Yes.	Yes.	Majority.
Avoid main move altogether	I object to the consideration of question.	You can interrupt a speaker; your name need not be on the board.	No.	No.	No.	2/3 negative.
Take matter from table	I move to take from table.	You must not interrupt a speaker; your name must be on the board.	Yes.	No.	No.	Majority.
Cancel main move	I move to rescind.	You must not interrupt a speaker; your name must be on the board.	Yes.	Yes.	Yes.	Requires 2/3 vote of members present, or majority vote of entire membership if previous notice has been given for that particular move to be rescinded.
